## **2019 IST Kid's Program Policies and Procedures Parental Agreement**

Parents are hereby notified that children are their sole responsibility when they are visiting the Mosque, especially during all prayers (daily, Friday and Ramadan). The IST Majlis Al Shura has decided on the following policies to foster a welcoming and beneficial environment during regular lectures and Taraweeh, to ensure the safety of the children and to observe the sanctity of the Mosque.

**\*IST will offer a children's program during Taraweeh for a minimal fee of \$3/\$5 a day per a child for children up to age 14 years old. The children's program policies are as follows:**

**\*Please initial each statement, if you agree and understand\***

\_\_\_\_\_ The children's program is for children whose parent or legal guardian is attending the program. Parent or guardian must sign the children into the program by filling out the sign in sheet. **All fees are due at sign in.**

\_\_\_\_\_ Please make sure your child is fed prior to entering Children's Program. Due to the risk of food allergies, **NO peanut products are allowed.**

\_\_\_\_\_ For the safety and security of the Children's Program participants, we do not allow any parents or guardians into the space.

\_\_\_\_\_ Parents will be asked to intervene and/or pick up the child from the program if a child exhibits excessive emotional distress (crying, screaming for longer than 10-15 minutes or if they present disruptive behavior.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Any behavior that endangers any of the participants will result in immediate removal from the program.** This includes violent behaviors such as biting, pinching, hitting, kicking, pulling hair, scratching, etc. Offensive language will not be tolerated. If children threaten or fight with each other, parents must be notified, and a warning may be given to the parents to help their children learn proper etiquettes and behavior.

\_\_\_\_\_ **If your child misbehaves, the teacher will give the child a verbal warning. If the child continues to misbehave the child will receive a "write up" which will be given to the parent at the end of the night. After 3 "write ups", the child will no longer be allowed to participate in the class.**

\_\_\_\_\_ The welfare of the child comes first. All children have the right to protection from abuse. All suspicions and allegations of abuse will be taken seriously and reported promptly to the appropriate authorities.

\_\_\_\_\_ Once your child is signed into the Program, they will not be allowed to leave without a staff member or the parent/guardian's signature on the sign in sheet.

\_\_\_\_\_ Children with the following physical signs and symptoms may not be dropped off due to risk of exposure: Diarrhea, temperature of 100 degrees or above, runny nose, coughing, rashes including chicken pox, and ringworm, conjunctivitis, or other sign of contagious illness. Your child must be fever-free for at least 24 hours before being left in program.

\_\_\_\_\_ Please be sure to label your child's belongings. We are not responsible for lost or broken items such as toys or electronic devices. They are best left at home.

\_\_\_\_\_ Only the parent or legal guardian who signed a child into the Program can pick the child up unless otherwise indicated to a staff member at time of sign-in.

## 2019 **IST Kid's Program Policies and Procedures Parental Agreement**

Everyone is encouraged to attend the programs that are offered at IST. **However, parents who choose NOT to attend are responsible for keeping their children with them at all times. The exception is during Taraweeh, when all children 3-14 years old must be signed into programs whether or not their parents are actively praying.**

The following rules of conduct for children are to be observed while on IST property:

\_\_\_\_\_ Children must be in the care of and under the direct supervision of their parents. Children are not allowed to roam the facility or outside premises, especially the parking lot without parental supervision at any time. Parents must be within 5 feet of their children unless the children are participating in an IST program.

\_\_\_\_\_ No running is allowed anywhere in the building.

\_\_\_\_\_ No food or drink is allowed in the prayer hall and carpeted area.

\_\_\_\_\_ No yelling, screaming, or other forms of disturbance such as fighting, offensive language, etc on campus.

\_\_\_\_\_ No playing with or riding of outdoor sports equipment such as balls, bikes scooters, etc inside the center or in the parking lot unless in a designated are by IST.

\_\_\_\_\_ Parents will be responsible to repair any damages that IST incurs due to negligence on behalf of their children.

\_\_\_\_\_ Parents will not try to sign children out of programs during emergencies –tornado warnings, lock downs, etc.

\_\_\_\_\_ To abide by the City of Tulsa noise ordinances. IST will close all outside activities by 11:00 p.m. on weekdays and midnights on weekends. During Ramadan, all outside activities must comply with city ordinances but inside activities end when Taraweeh is done.

### **Tulsa Municipal Code Chapter 14: Disturbing the Peace**

It shall be an offense for any person to willfully or maliciously disturb the public peace or quietude or the life, health or safety of any individual in any manner, by creating any **noise** of such character or duration so as to be unreasonably loud or disturbing, including but not limited to the following:... in any manner or in such volume, particularly during the hours between **11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.**, so as to unreasonably disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of any person in any dwelling, hotel or other type of residence;
